Subject	Police and Crime Plan 2017/2021 Annual Review
Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the annual review of the Police and Crime Plan 2017/21.

DECISION

1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 (the Act) requires the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) to issue, as soon as possible within the financial year following the election, a Police and Crime Plan (Plan). When issuing the Plan, the Commissioner must have regard to the Strategic Policing Requirement (SPR) which is set by the Home Secretary and covers issues such as terrorism, civil emergencies, Cybercrime, serious and organised crime, child sexual abuse and public order. Both the PCC and the Chief Constable must have regard to the Plan when carrying out their functions.
2. The PCC may vary the Plan at any time (S 5(4) of the Act) and has a duty to keep the Plan under review
3. It has been agreed that no changes will be made to the Plan for the 2018/19 financial year.
4. I will however review the Plan during the 2018/19 financial year to ensure key areas such as the ongoing work on Modern Slavery that are being undertaken by my office and Gwent Police are reflected within the Plan for 2019/20. This work will be undertaken in consultation with Gwent Police, local partners and the Police and Crime Panel.
