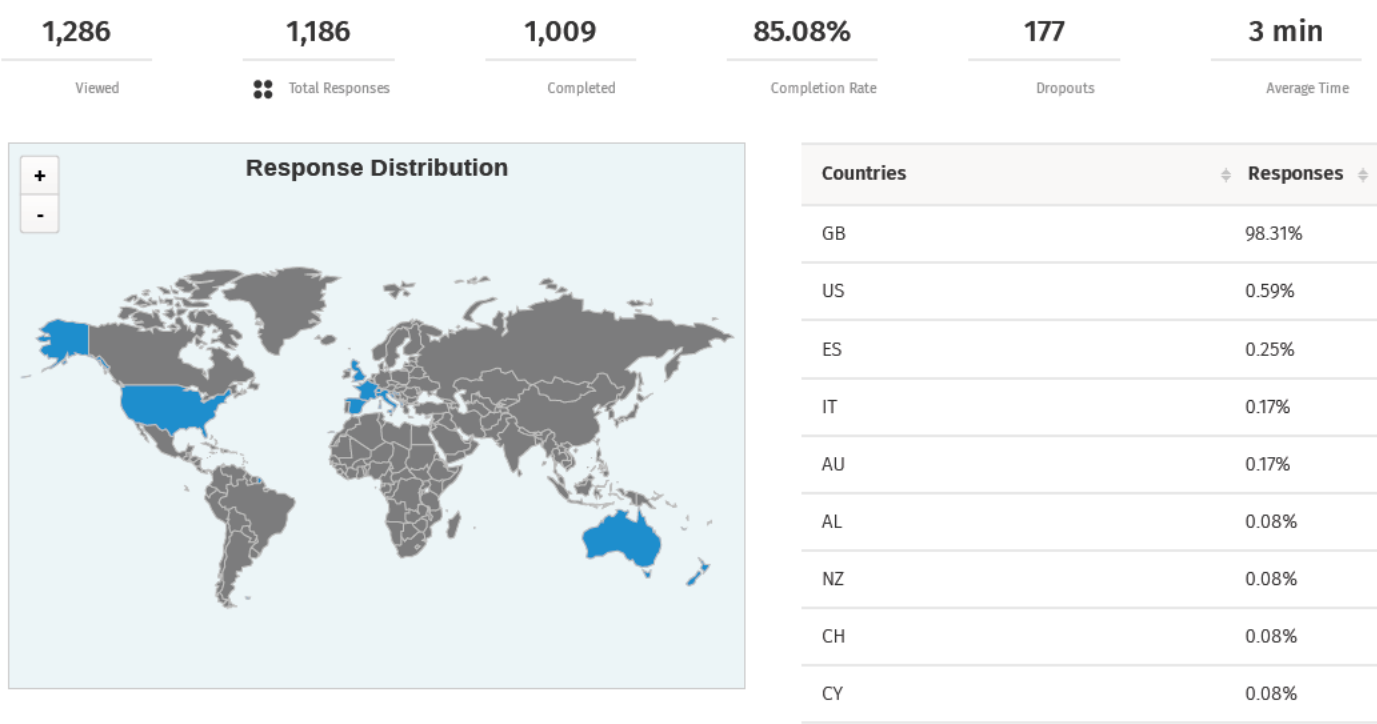

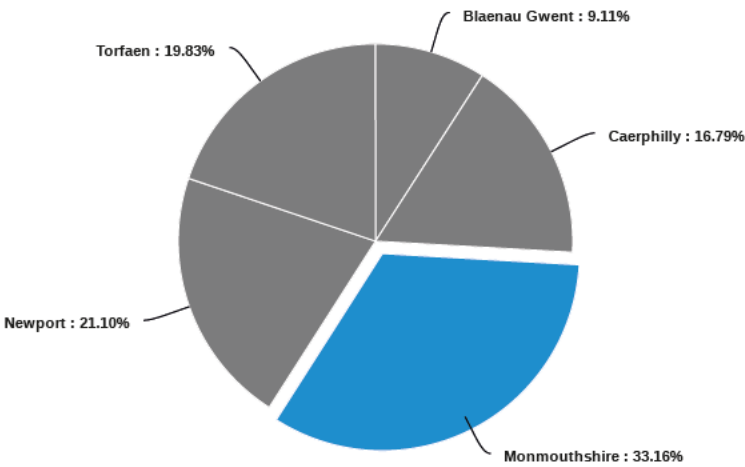

Response Distribution



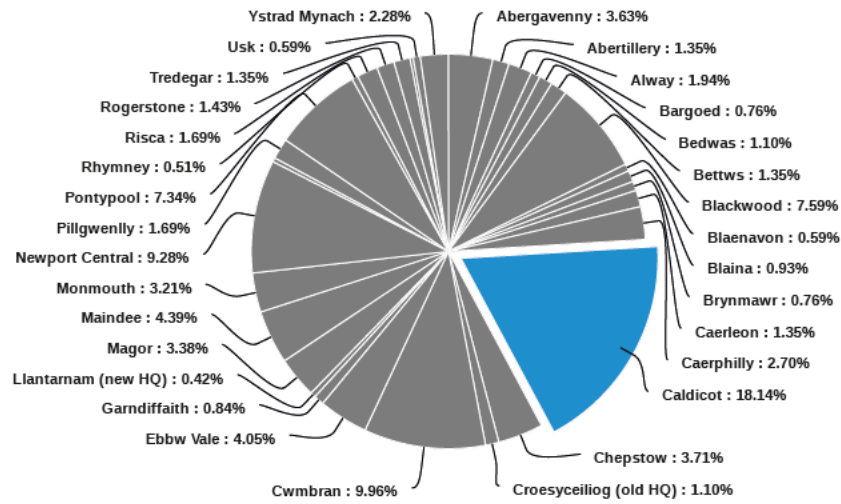

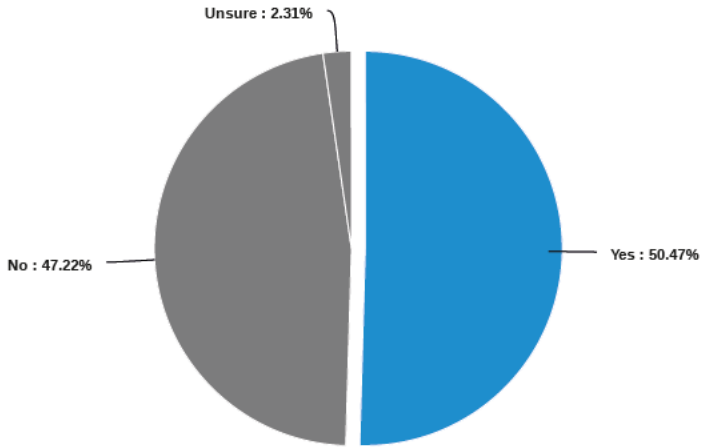

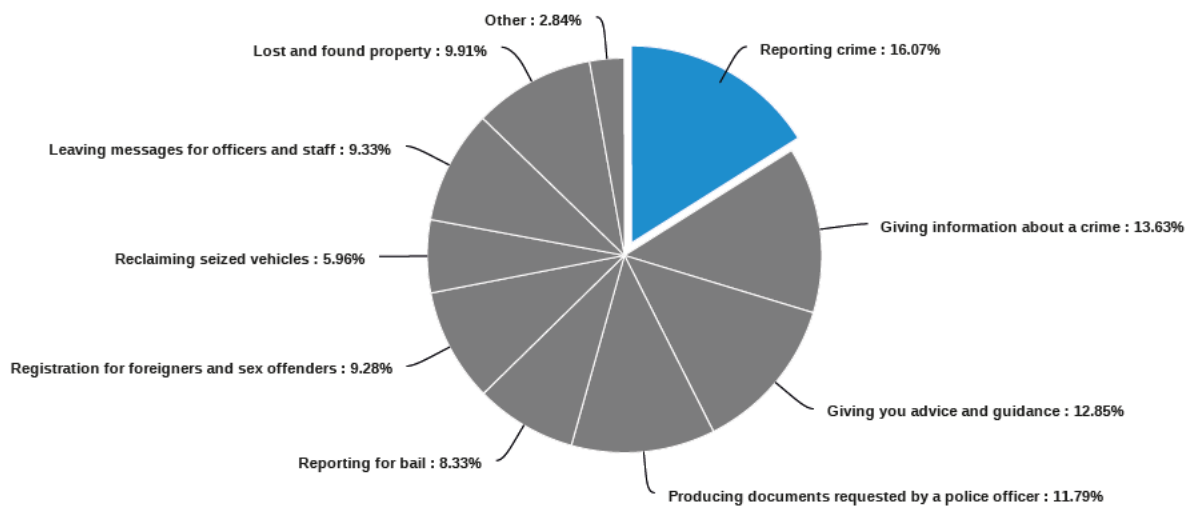

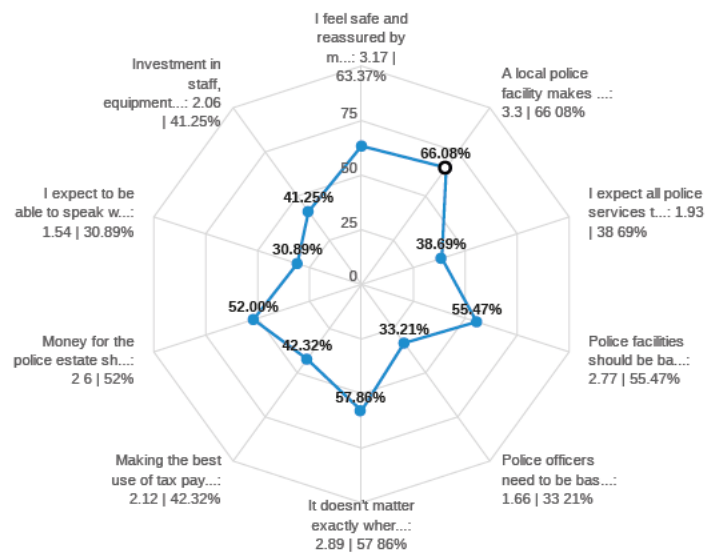

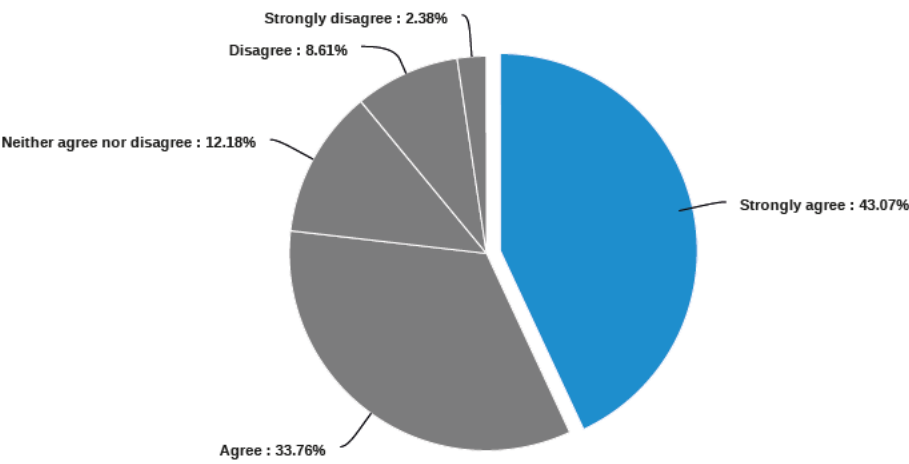

A local police facility makes me feel safer than seeing foot patrols or police cars in my area



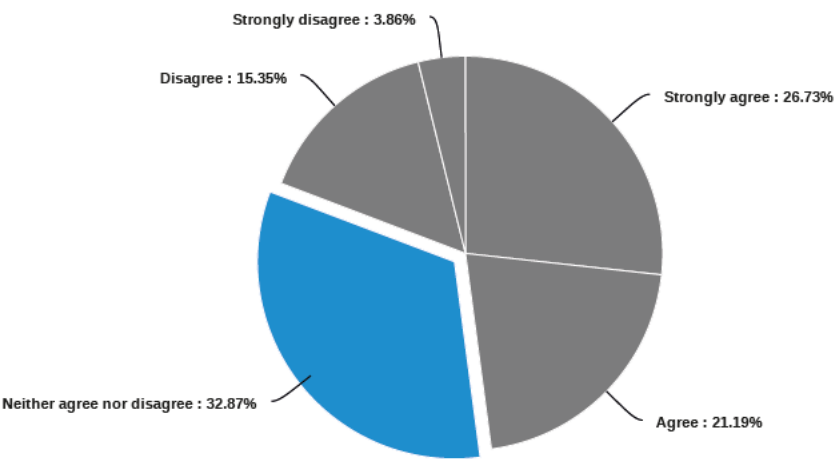

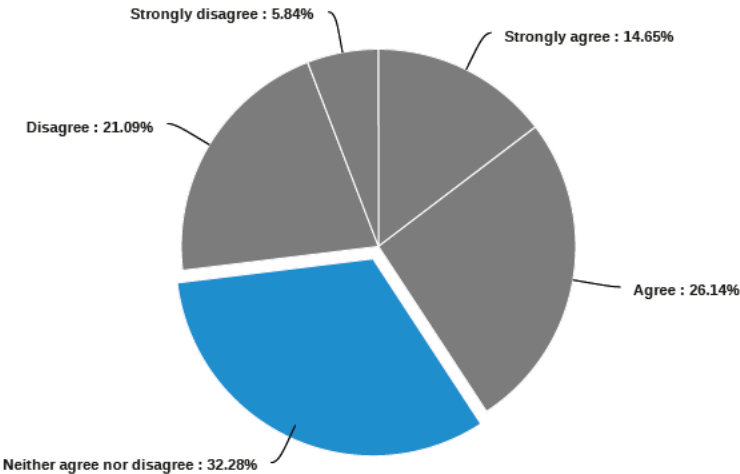

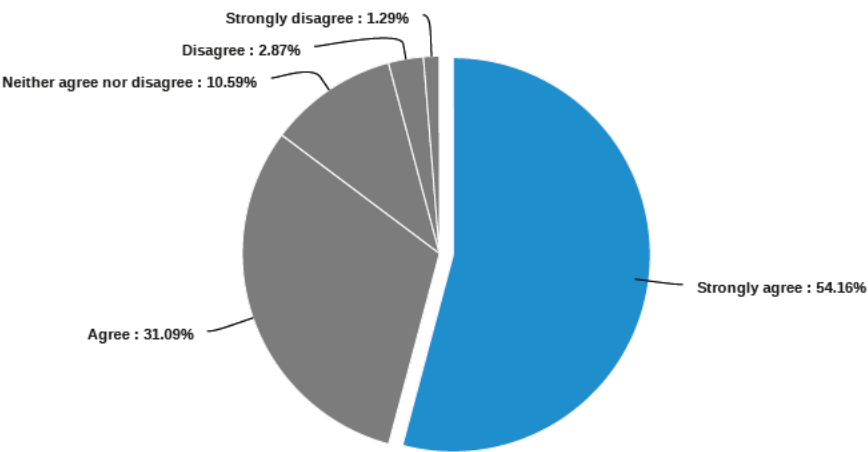

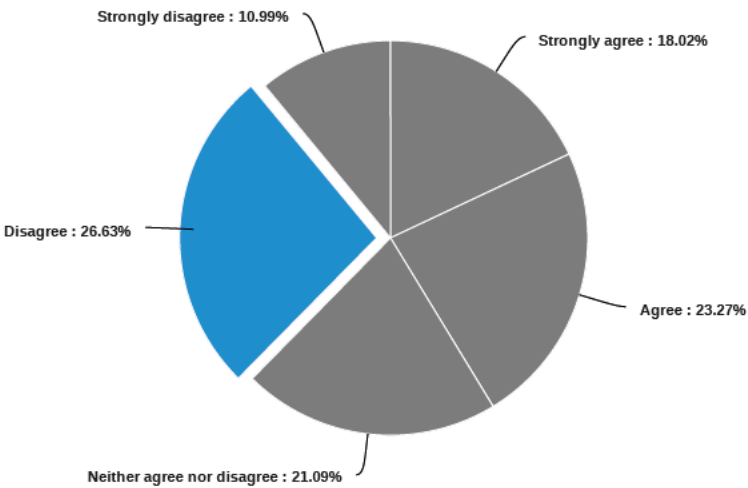

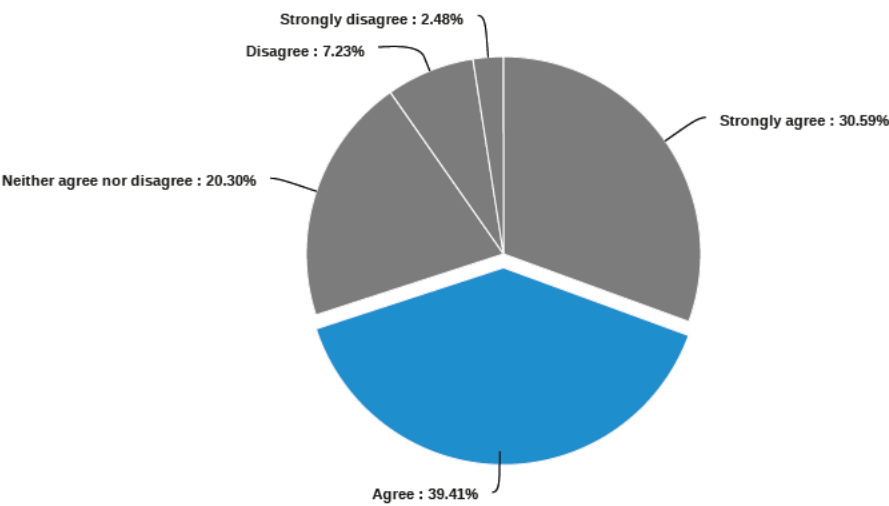

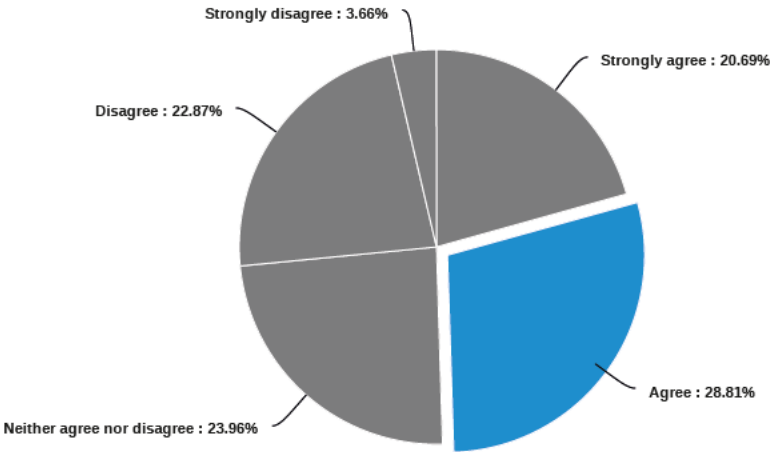

Making the best use of tax payers’ money is important when deciding where to invest in police facilities



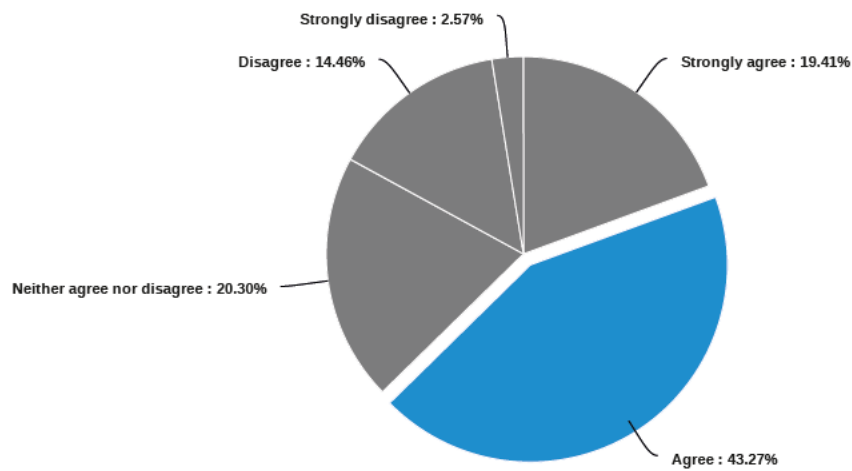

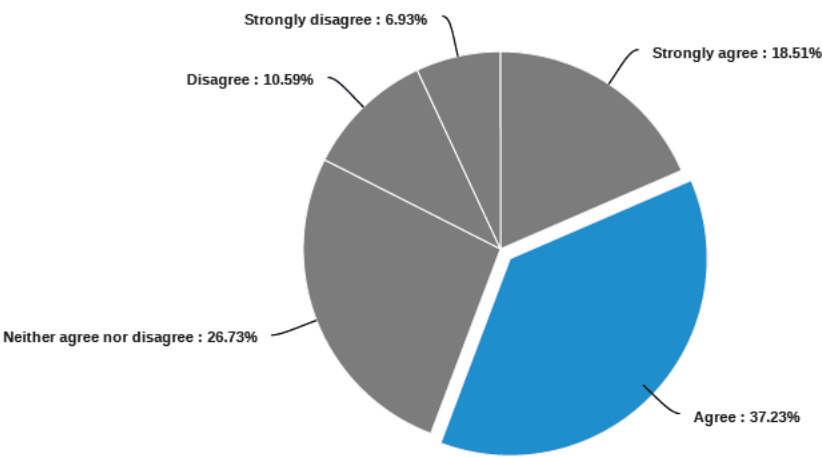

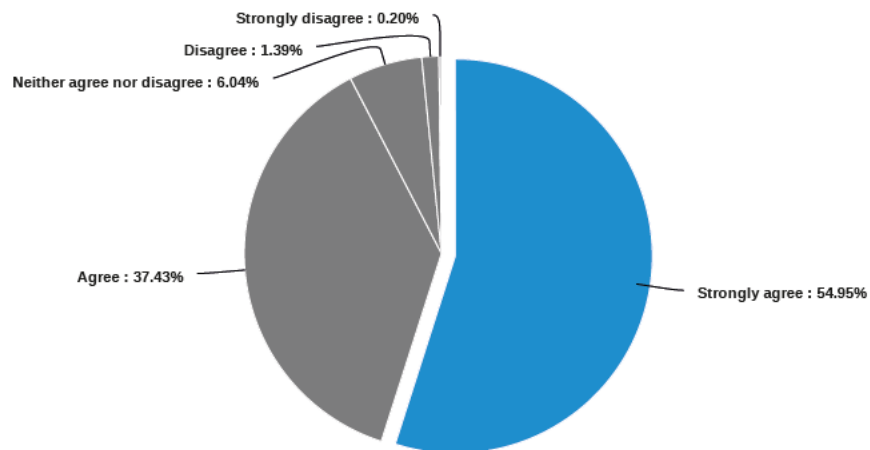

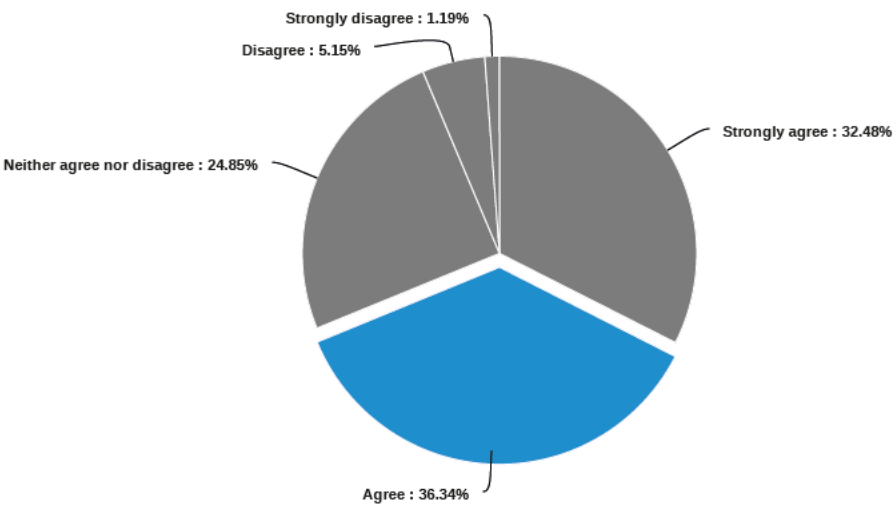

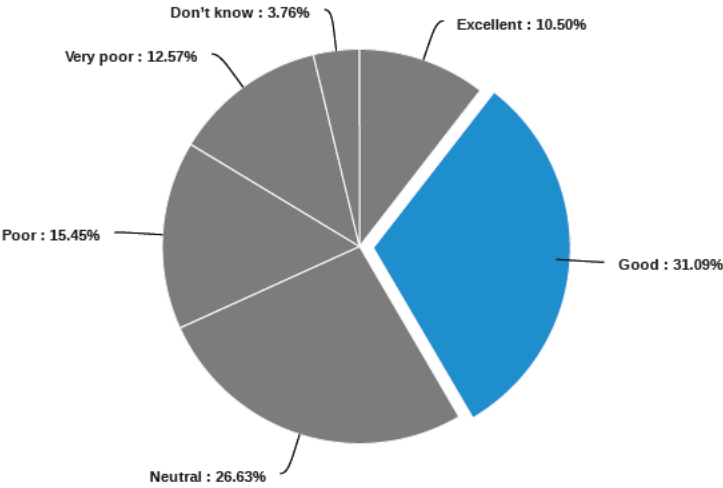

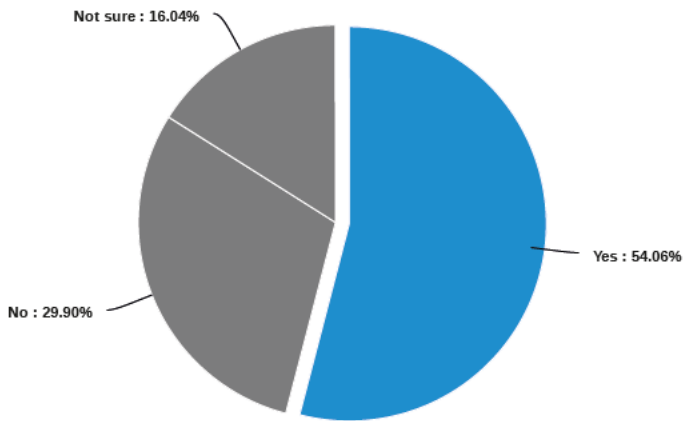

Do you think it is appropriate that some of the council tax precept for policing is used to pay for buildings, vehicles and computer technology?



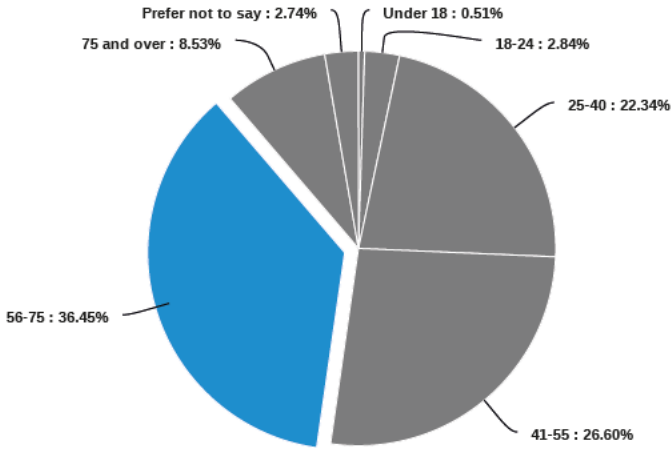

How much of the council tax precept for policing do you think is reasonable to spend on buildings, vehicles and computer technology?



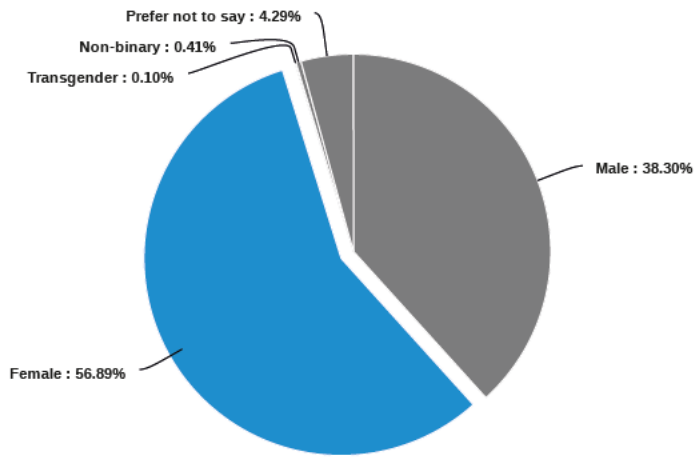

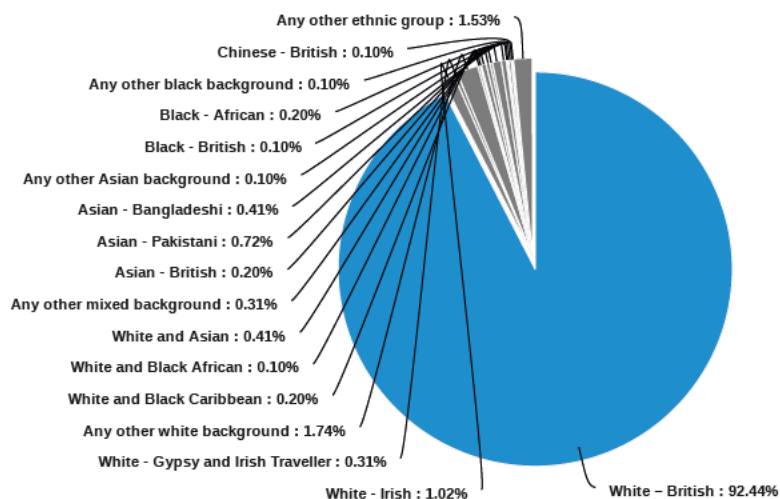

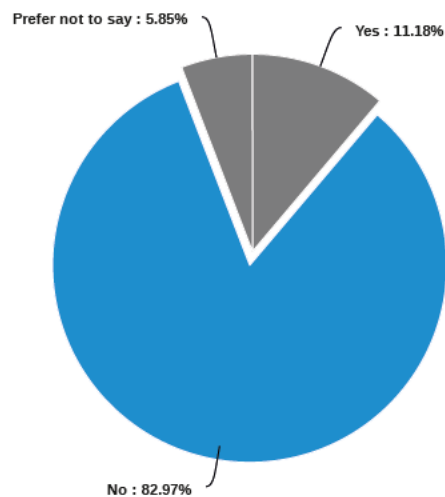
