

Subject	Sale of 9 the Highway New Inn, (formerly New Inn Police Station)
Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the sale to the Gwent Police Federation the property at 9, The Highway, New Inn, Torfaen.

DECISION

- On the 23rd December 2014 at the Strategy and Performance Board I received a briefing on the proposed sale of 9 The Highway to The Police Federation. The purchase was to be at market value. It was agreed that the building would continue to be branded with the Force logo and if any member of the public call at the premises, they would be assisted by staff of the Police Federation. The Force would also be at liberty to use the meeting rooms for meetings by the local policing team if required. It was also agreed that the Chief Constable would enter into a facilities agreement with the Federation similar to those between other forces and their Federation colleagues in England and Wales.
- I confirm that the property has been purchased by the Police Federation in the sum of £125,000.
