Summary	The purpose of this paper is to record the decision to provide a sum of £1,000.00 per annum for the period 13 / 14, 14 / 15 and 15 / 16 from the Positive Impact Fund to the Gwent Police Choir.

As a representative body of Gwent Police and myself, they are instrumental in engaging and providing charitable support to communities both within and outside of Gwent

Further to my earlier decision of PCCG-2013-123, when I established a recurrent fund of £10,000 known as the Positive Impact Fund (PIF), I have decided that I will provide financial support to the Gwent Police Choir by providing them with £1,000.00 per annum from this fund for the period 13 / 14, 14 / 15 and 15 / 16.
