Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner to agree to the deployment of a police officer to provide support during a misconduct appeal.	

DECISION

- 1. Section 26 of the Police Act 1996 requires that the Police and Crime Commissioner authorises the travel and attendance overseas of any officer or staff member providing assistance to an internal organisation or any other body which is engaged outside the UK in policing activities.
- 2. Following such a request from the Chief Officer Sovereign Base Areas in Cyprus for an officer to provide advice and guidance in relation to an appeal as a result of a misconduct hearing, I approved the Chief Constable's decision to deploy one Chief Superintendent to Cyprus for 12 days from 30th March 2019.
- 3. The request also had the support of the Chief Constable National Lead for Professional Standards matters.
- 4. The request was submitted to the Home Secretary on 19th February 2019 with approval granted on 22nd March 2019.
