

Subject	Extension of Tenure for Voluntary Scheme Members
Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the extension of tenures of members of the Independent Custody Visiting and Animal Welfare Schemes.

## DECISION

1. The recent outbreak of the Coronavirus has seen unprecedented decisions made for the welfare of the country.
2. In light of the disruption caused by Coronavirus and in order to provide continuity, the tenures for both the Animal Welfare and Independent Custody Visiting Scheme volunteers will be extended by one year for those volunteers whose tenure was due to end in 2021.
