1.	RECOMMENDATION	
1.1	To inform the Commissioner of the sale of Rassau Police Station for the sum of £52,000.	
2.	INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND	
2.1	Gwent Police Authority authorised the disposal of the property on the 28 <sup>th</sup> July 2011 following a three month period of engagement with the community. Services in the community have been re-provisioned.	
	Rassau Police Station has been marketed for sale by Estate Agents Bruton Knowles on behalf of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Gwent.	
3.	ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION	
3.1	An offer of £52,000 has been accepted by the Agents and approved by the District Valuer as best value.	
	The contracts of sale have been completed and are ready to be signed and sealed.	
	The Manual of Corporate Governance agrees a delegation of property transactions up to a value of £80,000 to the Chief Financial Officer of the Chief Constable (paragraph 6.25).	
4.	NEXT STEPS	
4.1	To sign, seal and complete the contract for sale of Rassau Police Station.	
5.	FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS	
5.1	There will be a capital receipt of £52,000 for the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. There will be agency and legal costs of approximately £2,000, generating net proceeds of £50,000.
