1.	RECOMMENDATION						
1.1	It is recommended that the contract for the Provision of Cabling Services be awarded to Supplier B, in accordance with Paragraph 66c of Manual of Governance.						
1.2	The Contract is to be awarded for a period of three (3) years with an option to extend for an additional one (1) year period.						
1.3	The Contract is awarded under the National Procurement Service for Wales (NPS) Framework for Structured Cabling Services Agreement (NPS-ICT-0041-15) Lot 3 – South East Wales.						
2.	INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND						
2.1	Previously, a member of staff from the Shared Resource Services (SRS) worked solely on force cabling requirements. The member of staff left the SRS in December 2015 and as an interim measure Gwent Police utilised the SRS's external contractors until the NPS framework had been awarded.						
2.2	Following award of the framework, a meeting was held between Gwent Police and SRS to establish a collaborative contract for cabling services (gener cabling and project cabling) and a specification drafted.						
	The organisations detailed within the specification who are able to utilise to collaborative contract are; • Gwent Police • Torfaen County Borough Council* • Monmouthshire County Council* • Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council* • Newport City Council* *These Organisations are part of the Shared Resource Service (SRS)						
2.3	The contract will be managed on a daily basis by the by the SRS. Should any new organisations come on board with the SRS during the time of the contract then their requirements will be covered, due to the management of any requests for cabling services being carried out directly by the SRS.						

3.	ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION				
3.1	The mini competition invitation to tender (ITT) document was issued to the three suppliers under Lot 3 of the NPS Framework. Two suppliers submitted responses, which were evaluated by the SRS Assistant Director and SRS Network Architect. The evaluation process was facilitated by a Senior Procurement Officer, Gwent Police.				
	The third supplier did not respond to the tender opportunity.				
3.2	Within the framework guidance provided by the NPS as part of the award process, award criteria for mini competitions were able to be varied to better meet the needs of individual contracts. The quality criteria percentage range was between 10% and 90% and the price criteria percentage range was between 10% and 90%. Between representatives of Gwent Police and SRS, a decision was made to go for quality at 30% and price at 70%, as it was deemed that price was more important for this provision.				
3.3	Below is a full breakdown of the scores achieved by the two suppliers following the evaluation of their tender responses for Quality (30%) and Cost (70%) criteria;

4.1	On approval of this report, the Call-Off document will be completed in accordance with the mini competition process and the NPS Framework, then issued to Supplier B for signing.				
5.	FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS				
5.1	The estimated annual value for the provision of cabling services for the organisations listed in paragraph 2.2 is £62,115, which incorporates general cabling work and project work. The breakdown between organisations are listed below;

5.2	The total value for this contract is £268,460 for the four year period.
