Summary	The purpose of this paper is to record the decision to provide financial support to the Wings To Fly programme via Blackwood Crime Prevention Panel.



## **DECISION**

1. The Wings to Fly production forms part of the Drugs & Substance Misuse strand of the All Wales School Liaison Core Programme (A.W.S.L.C.P.) and as well as the live performances, Year 6 pupils (10-11 year olds) benefit from follow up lessons related to drug education delivered by the School Community Police Officers (S.C.P.O.s). Wings To Fly links to and complements the following priorities identified by the PCC:
  - To reduce and prevent crime
  - To protect people from serious harm
  - To take more effective action to reduce anti-social behaviour.
2. I have decided that I will provide financial support to the 2013/14 Wings To Fly events for technical support, refreshments (Blaenau Gwent and Caerphilly) and transport (Caerphilly) for respective schools to attend. The estimated overall cost is £8,000.  
  
I have agreed with the event organisers, Blackwood Crime Prevention Panel, that they will receive the funds granted and process the invoices via their financial accounting mechanisms.
3. The grant is provided as part of my commissioning activity for the financial period on the basis that I will receive such information as necessary to reassure me that the grant funding has been used effectively to provide a service that supports my Police and Crime priorities.
