<b>Subject</b>	<b>Launch of PCC Police Community Fund</b>
<b>Summary</b>	<b>To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the launch of the PCC Police Community Fund for 2018/19.</b>

## **DECISION**

1. **The PCC Police Community Fund grant scheme has been created to target the monies received through the Proceeds of Crime Act and from the sale of unclaimed, found property, so that we support organisations in some of the most disadvantaged areas in Gwent.**
2. **Organisations / groups interested in bidding for a share of the £300,000 annual funding must be able to demonstrate the positive impact their project will have on the communities they serve. The Fund is targeted at supporting organisations/groups seeking to help children and young people who may be in danger of entering the criminal justice system or have become victims. Projects will need to deliver against the priorities in the Commissioner's Police and Crime Plan. Fundamental to these projects is the role of Neighbourhood Policing in engaging with organisations to achieve the work required. Groups will be able to apply for funding from £10,000 up to and in the region of £50,000. Should any bids require a sum less than £10,000 or greater than £50,000, they are still eligible to submit their bid for consideration as alternative or additional funding may be made available if the concept is recommended to be pursued.**
3. **The Funding will be made available beyond an initial 12 month period, for up to 3 years to effect positive change and will be provided annually over the course of the funding term. Funds will be accessed by a bid process and funding made available on a Grant Award basis. Subsequent decision logs recording the funding awarded will be provided at least six monthly based on any funding being agreed.**
4. **I approve the opening of the PCC Police Community Fund for bids from organisations, charities, voluntary organisations and community groups. Applications will be received on a quarterly basis for review at quarterly panel meetings.**
