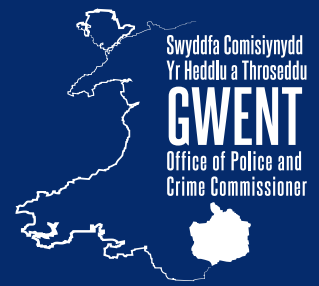


Police and Crime Commissioner for Gwent Budget 2017/2018



Dear Resident,
As the Police and Crime Commissioner for Gwent it is my responsibility to ensure that you have appropriate levels of policing. Setting the precept (the police element of your council tax) and preparing and setting the annual budget for policing and crime services is one of the most important responsibilities I have.

I want to ensure that every pound spent by the police in Gwent is a pound well spent and I remain committed to ensuring the Force has the resources it needs, and that you receive the police service you deserve. In determining the budget for 2017/18, I have taken into account the Chief Constable's requirements to deliver

operational policing; the cost of which accounts for the majority of my police and crime budget. The remainder of my budget is then used to commission services from providers outside the Gwent Police, to deliver against my Police and Crime Plan priorities.

These are very challenging financial times as policing budgets continue to be squeezed and my budget is built on the success of a major efficiency programme delivered by the Force. As a result of a significant reduction in Central Government grants to frontline policing over the last six years and continuing future cuts, Gwent Police will potentially face a deficit of £58.7 million between the period 2008/09 to 2020/21. To date the policing service in Gwent has delivered over £42 million of efficiency savings to address this gap, resulting in losing over 300 officers and over 250 staff.

To partially offset the remaining impact of this funding gap, whilst being mindful of the financial pressures facing residents in these times of austerity, I have decided to set the increase on the police precept on residential properties at **3.99%** for 2017/18. This means that the average Gwent household (Band D properties) will pay an additional

17 pence a week for their policing and related services in 2017/18.

In return, this increase will enable Gwent Police to invest in tackling emerging crimes such as cyber fraud and to recruit up to 120 much-needed police officers over the next year to bolster the frontline. This ensures that the Force can continue to meet the demands of modern day policing and keep you safe. This produces a challenging but achievable budget to deliver my police and crime priorities and protect your services.

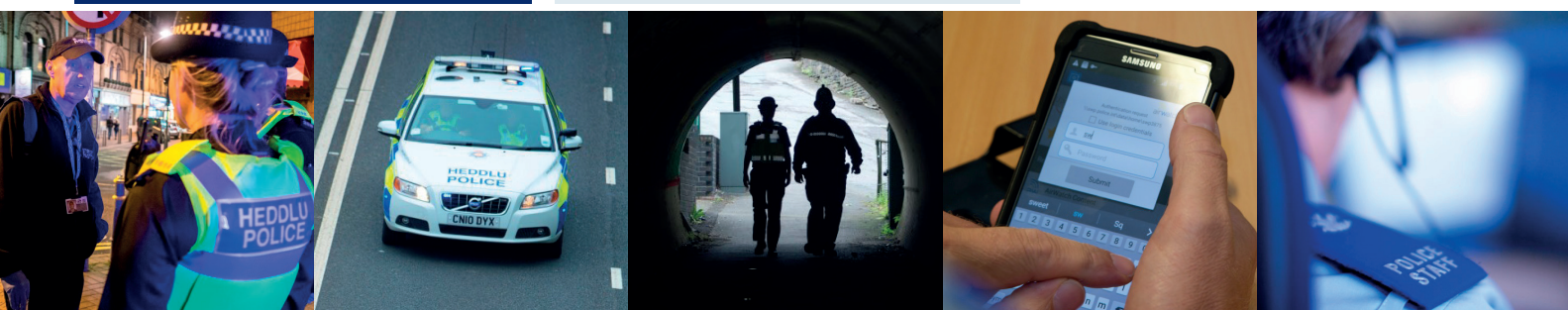

Annwyl Breswlydd,
A minnau'n Gomisiynydd yr Heddlu a Throseddau Gwent, fy nghyfrifoldeb i yw sicrhau bod gennych lefelau plismona priodol. Mae gosod y praesept (elfen yr heddlu o dreth y cyngor) a pharatoi a gosod y gyllideb flynyddol ar gyfer gwasanaethau plismona a throseddau yn un o'r cyfrifoldebau pwysicaf sydd gen i.

Rwyf am sicrhau bod pob punt a warir gan yr heddlu yng Ngwent yn bunt a wariwyd yn dda ac yr wyf yn parhau'n ymrwymedig i sicrhau bod gan yr Heddlu yr adnoddau mae eu hangen, ac eich bod yn derbyn y gwasanaeth heddlu rydych yn ei haeddu. Wrth benderfynu ar y gyllideb ar gyfer 2017/18, rwyf wedi ystyried gofynion y Prif Gwnstabl o ran darparu plismona gweithredol.

Cost y gofynion hyn sydd i gyfrif am y rhan fwyaf o'm cyllideb heddlu a throseddau. Wedyn defnyddir gweddill fy nghyllideb i gomisiynu gwasanaethau gan ddarparu'r y tu allan I Heddlu Gwent, er mwyn cyflawni blaenoriaethau fy Nghynllun Heddlu a Throseddau.

Mae hwn yn gyfnod ariannol heriol iawn wrth y gyllidebau plismona barhau i gael eu gwasgu ac mae fy nghyllideb wedi ei adeiladu ar lwyddiant rhaglen effeithlonrwydd sylweddol a gyflwynir gan yr Heddlu.

O ganlyniad i ostyngiad sylweddol yng ngrantiau'r Llywodraeth Ganolog ar gyfer plismona rheng flaen dros y pum mlynedd diwethaf, a thoriadau pellach yn y dyfodol, mae'n bosibl y bydd Heddlu Gwent yn wynebu diffyg o £58.7 miliwn am y cyfnod rhwng 2008/09 i 2020/21. Hyd yn hyn, mae'r gwasanaeth plismona yng Ngwent wedi gwneud dros £42 miliwn o arbedion effeithlonrwydd er mwyn mynd I'r afael â'r bwch hwn, gan gollu dros 300 o swyddogion a dros 250 o staff.

Er mwyn gwrthbwyso'n rhannol weddill effaith y bwch cyllido hwn, a chan gofio'r pwysau ariannol sy'n wynebu trigolion yn y cyfnod hwn o galedi, rwyf wedi penderfynu pennu'r

cynnydd i braesept yr heddlu o ran eiddo preswyl ar gyfradd o **3.99%** ar gyfer 2017/18. Golyga hyn y bydd cartref cyffredin yng Ngwent (eiddo Band D) yn talu **17 ceiniog** yr wythnos yn ychwanegol am blismona a gwasanaethau cysylltiedig yn 2016/17. Yn gyfnewid am hynny, bydd y cynnydd hwn yn galluogi Heddlu Gwent i fuddsoddi ar fynd i'r afael a throseddau sy'n dod i'r amlwg megis twyll seiber ac i iecriwtio hyd at 120 o heddweision i atgyfnerthu'r rheng flaen dros y flwyddyn nesaf. Bydd hyn yn sicrhau gall Heddlu Gwent barhau i fodloni gofynion plismona modern ac i'ch cadw'n ddiogel. Felly mae'r gyllideb yn heriol ond yn gyraeddadwy, a hynny er mwyn cyflawni fy mlaenoriaethau heddlu a throseddau.
