Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the commencement of the appointment for a Chief Constable

DECISION


1. Mrs Napier, the previous Chief Constable for Gwent, retired from office on 7th June 2013 with immediate effect. There is now a need to appoint a new Chief Constable as soon as possible.
2. The Commissioner has the power to appoint a Chief Constable as per Schedule 8(2) of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, subject to a confirmation hearing by the Police and Crime Panel.
3. It is recommended that:
 - i) approval is given to commence the recruitment process for the next Chief Constable;
 - ii) comments are provided on the draft role profile; and
 - iii) approval is given for Mrs Gill Parker to be the independent person on the appointment panel.
