- 1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 provides under sections 9 and 10 that the Police and Crime Commissioner for a police area makes crime and disorder grants and acts in co-operation with responsible authorities and makes arrangements with criminal justice agencies for the exercise of functions so as to provide an efficient and effective criminal justice system for the area.
- I have considered the requirements under the Act, the current service provision landscape in Gwent and the progress made to date in producing a comprehensive grant commissioning framework. I have also facilitated inclusion into the process of Safer Gwent members to devise the application process and assess funding allocations. I have considered the Strategic Commissioning Board recommendations and decided to distribute each of the respective grants to the various organisations in accordance with the schedule attached at Annex A.
- 3. Each of these organisations will need to provide me with such information to reassure me that the funding allocated is being used effectively to provide a service that meets my Policing Priorities for Gwent as stipulated in my Police and Crime Plan.
