### 1. RECOMMENDATION

The purpose of this report is to seek approval for funding for a further twelve months for substance misuse community prescribing service provision.

#### 2. INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

In 2009 Torfaen County Borough Council on behalf of the Gwent Drug Interventions Programme and the Community Safety Partnerships of Blaenau-Gwent, Caerphilly, Torfaen & Monmouthshire awarded a three year contract with an option to extend for a further two years (subject to performance) for substance misuse community prescribing services to Kaleidoscope. The contract commenced on 1 April 2010 and is available for use by Gwent Police who is a member of the community safety partnership.

In November 2012 the budget for the Drug Interventions Programme were transferred to the Commissioner along with responsibility for 3 staff members to commission the service.

#### 3. ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

Torfaen County Borough Council is in the process of extending the contract for the final year, 1 April 2014 until 31 March 2015 and has been informed of the Commissioner's intention to utilise the contract during the extension period once funding has been approved.

#### 4. NEXT STEPS

On approval of the funding, Torfaen County Borough Council will be informed of our continued requirements during 2014 – 2015.

### 5. FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The value of the contract from 1 April 2013 to 31 March 2014 will be £210, 000. Following negotiations with Kaleidoscope an annual cost saving of £10,000 has been achieved. The value of the contract from 1 April 2014 to 31 March 2015 for the service provision will be £200,000.

### 6. PERSONNEL CONSIDERATIONS

There are no personnel implications.
