2.	INTRODU	NTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND						
2.1	Gwent Police (GWP) current cleaning contract is with the supplier Solo Service Group following a compliant open OJEU tendering procedure in 2013. The contract commenced on the 01/10/2013 for an initial three year period, with an option to extend for twenty four months. The permitted 24 month extension was utilised to extend the contract to 30/09/2018. The contract was further extended outside of the original period (OPCC Decision number PCCG-2019-003) until 30/09/2019 to allow time to create tendering documentation and conduct a compliant mini competition.							
2.2	For this tender requirement the Estates department required a service that addresses the following:

Due to the required contract covering additional Facilities Management (FM) elements we were advised by NPS that the framework suitable would be Lot 1 - Soft Facilities Management Services of the NPS Framework Agreement FACILITIES MANAGEMENT SERVICES (MANAGED SERVICE) Ref: NPS-PS-0042-2015. NPS awarded Lot 1 of the Framework to seven suppliers.

3. GWP Estates team can hold an initial meeting and agree an implementation plan.				
4. Subject to bullets 1-3 the contract will be finalised and signed.

If this contract is not authorised, GWP could face a number of risk, the highest risk areas being Custody Units, Medical Rooms, SARC facilities and attending Major Incidents. In addition it would have a big impact on our domestic set up in the offices and administration buildings. Fulfilling these posts and securing vetted staff would take a considerable amount of time, all the while we could not function in the high risk areas without this service.
