Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the allocation of funding from the Police Commissioner's Partnership Fund	

DECISION

- 1. Previous publication of Decision number PCCG-2013-106 confirmed my intention to establish a recurrent commissioning fund (the Police Commissioner's Partnership Fund) of up to £100,000 to assist organisations involved in activities that reduce crime and anti-social behaviour or divert people away from related activity.
- 2. Following a public application process to the Fund throughout September and October 2013, the Funding Adjudication Panel undertook a rigorous assessment of all bids received by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner.
- 3. As a result of this assessment process, the Panel decided to award funds to the value of £99,470 to the projects listed at Appendix A of this document. In addition to the grants awarded, the Panel also made the decision not to fund a number of projects.
- 4. It is my intention to run the process again during the 2014/15 and 2015/16 periods.
