## **DECISION**

- 1. The Partnership Fund grant scheme is funded by the proceeds of crime awarded to the police and from the sale of unclaimed, found property.
- 2. Groups interested in bidding for a share of the £150,000 funding must be able to demonstrate the positive impact their project will have on the communities they serve, whilst at the same time contributing to delivering the Commissioner's priorities for Gwent which include reducing and preventing crime; taking more effective action to reduce anti-social behaviour and protecting people from serious harm. Groups will be able to apply for funding up to and in the region of £10,000.
