Subject	Police Commissioner's Community Safety Fund Award to Rhymney RFC
Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the allocation of funding from the Community Safety Fund to Rhymney RFC.

DECISION

1. The Community Safety Fund is a fund that exists to assist organisations involved in activities that reduce crime and anti-social behaviour or divert people away from related activity.
2. Rhymney RFC provides support to male and female teams across the age groups from 5 to 18 years of age.

There is a significant cost in being able to provide training venues for all the teams during the winter months particularly and because of an increase in cost announced recently.

Whilst they are proactively fund raising to cover the increased costs, they sought further support from the Police and Crime Commissioner so that they can keep all their young people engaged throughout the season.
3. Having assessed the application, I have decided to award funds to the value of £1,000.00 to the project to assist in the training provision for the winter season.
