Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the precept level for 2014/15.	

DECISION

- 1. As the Commissioner, I am required to determine the budget for 2014/15 and then set the Police Precept following consultation with the Gwent Police and Crime Panel.
- 2. Following constructive discussions during the meeting of the Police and Crime Panel in Usk on the 24th January 2014, I offered to revise downwards the amount Gwent residents should pay through the 2014/15 Council Tax Precept from an increase of 2.99% to an increase of 2.66%.
- 3. The average Gwent household would now pay £203.50 for their policing and related services during 2014/15 an increase of £5.27 a year or 44p a month on what they currently pay.
- 4. On the 3rd February 2014 I received a report from the Police and Crime Panel endorsing the revised precept increase of 2.66%. I will now issue the precept to the relevant billing Authorities.
