DECISION

- 1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 (the Act) requires Police and Crime Commissioners to publish a Police and Crime Plan by the end of the financial year in which they are elected. This feedback was considered and if deemed appropriate was included into the final Plan. This was presented to them at their meeting on 17th March 2017. The Police and Crime Panel members approved the final version of the Plan at this meeting.
- A copy of the Police and Crime Plan has been forwarded to the Chief Constable and the Police and Crime Panel. The plan will be available in Welsh.
- 5. I will keep the plan under review and as appropriate vary the plan after consultation with the Chief Constable, partners, the public and the Police and Crime Panel.
