

Subject	Strategic Policing Requirement (SPR)
Summary	To confirm that the Commissioner has considered the SPR and has had regard to its implications in the draft Police and Crime Plan 2013- 17

DECISION

1. In November 2012 I received a general briefing on the SPR and how the assessment of it, and the links to the ACPO/NPIA protective services minimum standards, were being considered both locally and in the region. Officers from my Office have been working closely with the Force to understand the implications in developing my draft police and crime plan.
2. On 14th February I received a more detailed briefing regarding the outcome of that assessment. I am aware of the areas of compliance and those areas identified for further development. I am aware of the links between local, regional and national and how these have been considered in developing the draft police and crime plan.
3. In broad terms I am satisfied that Gwent Police are compliant with the requirements of the SPR and that in those areas where there are known gaps these are either under development or a managed risk.
4. I have agreed that the force will monitor compliance with the SPR and any revisions to it on a quarterly basis and I will be briefed six monthly. There will be an annual review to link revisions to the Police and Crime plan.
