Subject	Police Commissioner's Partnership Fund 2015/16 – Funding Allocation
Summary	To record the decision of the Police and Crime Commissioner regarding the allocation of funding from the Police Commissioner's Partnership Fund 2015/16.

DECISION


1. Previous publication of Decision number PCCG-2013-106 confirmed my intention to establish a recurrent commissioning fund (the Police Commissioner's Partnership Fund) of up to £100,000 to assist organisations involved in activities that reduce crime and anti-social behaviour or divert people away from related activity. For 2014/2015, the amount was increased to £150,000.
2. Following a public application process to the Fund throughout February and March 2015, Stage 1 shortlisting against the application criteria was completed. Applicants who met the criteria moved forward to Stage 2 which consisted of an evaluation enquiry. All applications and evaluations from Stage 2 were presented to a Funding Adjudication Panel (which included officers from the OPCC along with representatives from the Community), in June 2015 who undertook a rigorous assessment of all the Stage 2 bids received by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner. A member of the Police and Crime Panel observed the process.
3. As a result of this assessment process, the Panel recommended a number of projects for me consider to the value of £153,085. Following a detailed consideration I agreed to support the projects listed at Appendix A of this document.
