Subject	Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner's Commissioning Budget
Summary	The purpose of this paper is to record the decision to provide a sum of £1,000.00 per annum for the period 14 / 15 and 15 / 16 from the Police Property Act fund to the District Crime Prevention Panels of Abertillery, Bargoed & Rhymney, Blackwood & Ystrad Mynach, Brynmawr, Caerphilly & Bedwas, Ebbw Vale, Risca and Tredegar (8) to assist them in running local crime prevention initiatives in support of the Commissioners Police and Crime Priorities and to assist them in advertising their panels.

DECISION

1.

The eight District Crime Prevention Panels are located in the Blaenau Gwent and Caerphilly Borough areas. The panels conform and are constituted to the Heddlu Gwent Police Partnerships Against Crime guidelines.

Panels are supported by force officers and are set up to assist with educating, promoting activity and public awareness by publicising crime prevention initiatives with the intention of supporting the reduction, the burden and effect of crime on the community.

Following my decision of 16th July 2013, to award a sum of £1,000.00 to each Panel, I have decided that I will offer the same sum of £1,000.00 to each of the eight panels, for the financial periods 14/15 and 15/16 (£16,000), to support them in delivering locally defined crime prevention initiatives and awareness raising of the panels with the local community. The panel initiatives will be required to support my priorities as stipulated in the Police and Crime Plan.


